He was the first Muslim king and founder of the Umayyad Dynasty.



ABBAS IBN ABDUL MUTALLIB

He was the uncle of the Prophet (saws) who made sure that the people of Ansar will protect the Prophet in Madinah even before he became a Muslim.

AISHA BINT ABI BAKR

She was a beloved wife of Prophet (saws). She narrated more Hadith than any other woman and was a great scholar of Islam.



SAUDA BINT ZAM'AH

She was the second woman that the Prophet (saws) married and helped raise his daughters.
